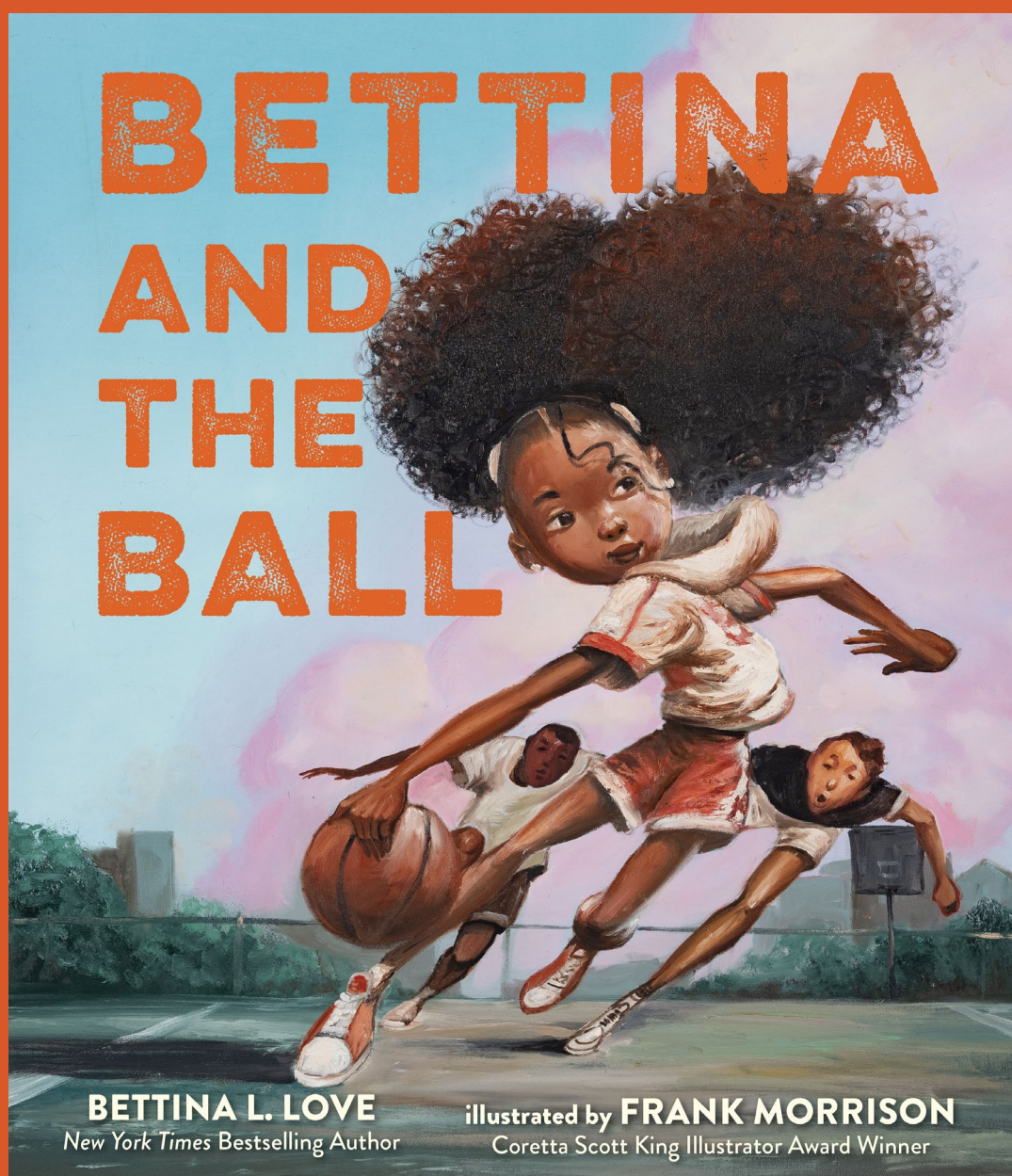

Bettina L. Love is a New York Times best-selling author, award-winning scholar, and the William F. Russell Professor at Teachers College, Columbia University. A former college basketball player and Big East Player of the Week, she led her team in blocked shots and, in 2023, received the Atlantic Coast Conference Unite Award for advancing racial progress on and off the court.

A nationally recognized voice in education, Dr. Love's work has transformed conversations about educational justice, inspiring educators, school leaders, students, and communities across the nation. She is the author of *We Want to Do More Than Survive: Abolitionist Teaching and the Pursuit of Educational Freedom*. She lives in New York City—and still loves playing basketball.

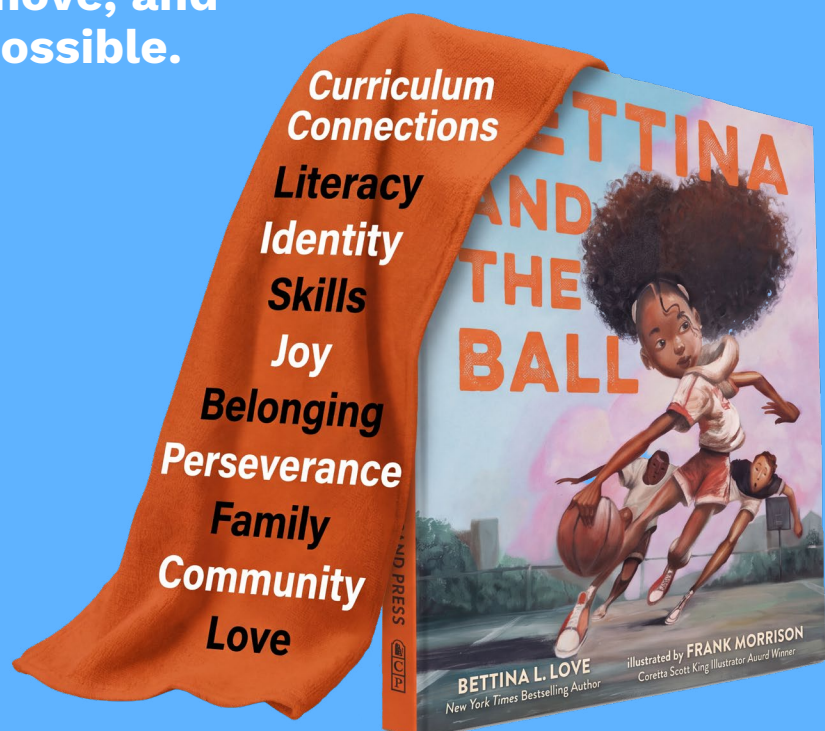

Together, these resources invite children to read, dream, move, and imagine what's possible.

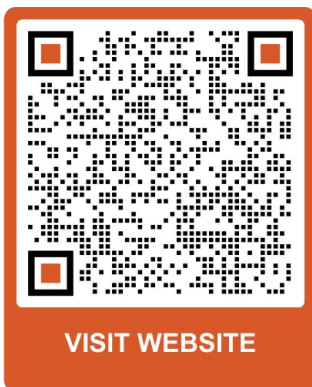

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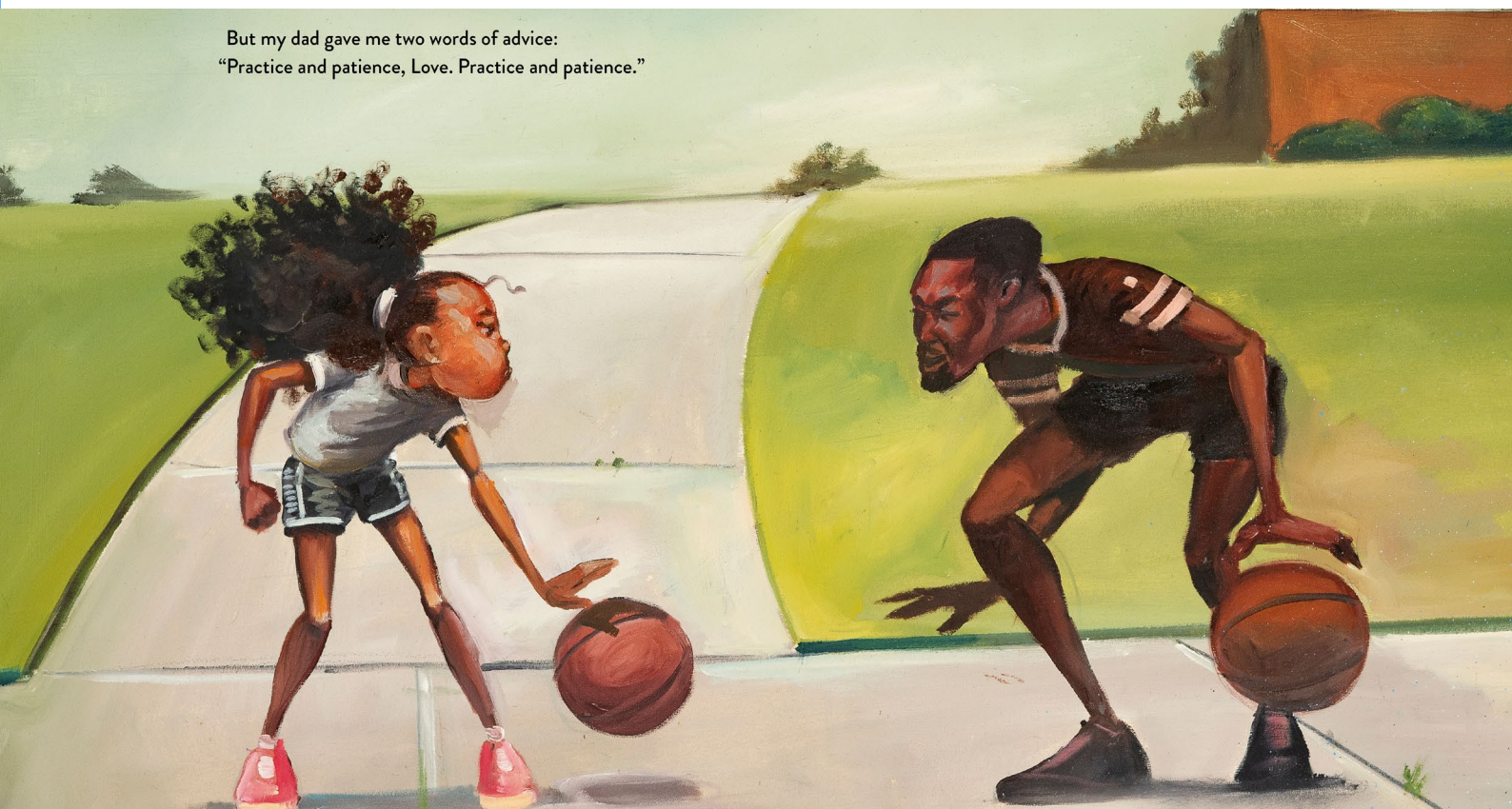
